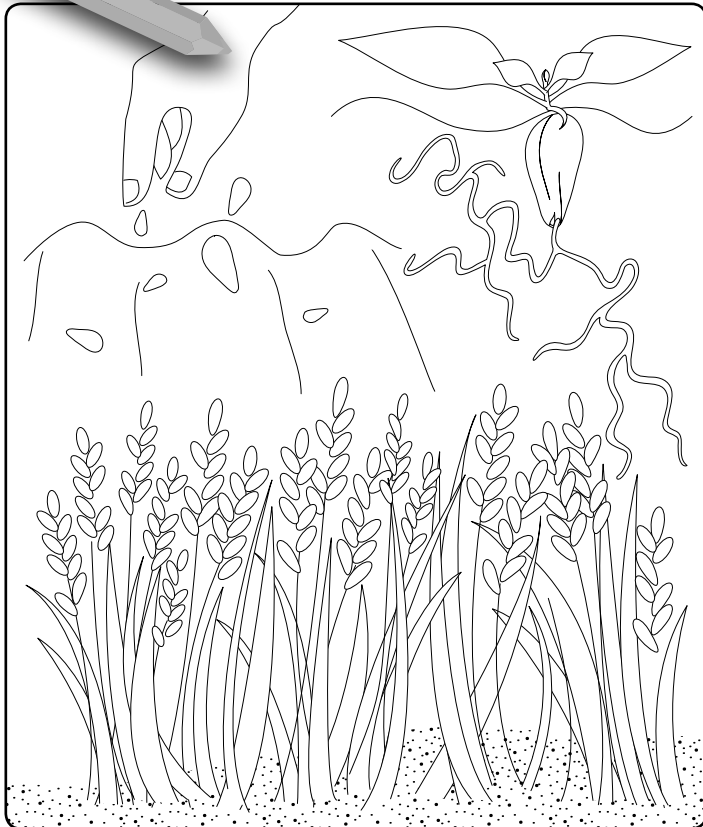


Today's Bible reading
